
Dear Ms. Mitchell:

The City of Corona appreciates the opportunity to respond to the Notice of Preparation (NOP) of a Draft Program Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) for the Public Safety Enterprise Communication (PSEC) project which is intended to update Riverside County's communication network. Although the City of Corona realizes the importance of such facilities it is also important to ensure that the facilities are located in a manner that meets that county's goals and needs while minimizing any impact to existing communities. As such, our comments are listed below.

1. The city requests that you properly analyze the aesthetics of each site (Cajalco, Corona, Green River and Temescal) within the City of Corona and its Sphere of Influence with respect to height, location, and land use compatibility as these sites are proposed at substantial heights that would have a significant impact on existing and future development within the aforementioned areas. We request that the analysis also look at alternative locations and the feasibility of co-locating on existing facilities where applicable. Furthermore, the "Corona" and "Green River" sites are situated in a State-eligible scenic corridor which traverses State Route 91 corridor from Interstate 15 west to State Route 55.
2. The city requests that you properly analyze the "Corona" site with respect to Riverside County's Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan as the proposed location is situated at the southerly boundary of the Corona Municipal Airport and Zone D (Primary Traffic Patterns and Runway Buffer Areas). Zone "D" prescribes a maximum height of 70 feet for all structures. Structures exceeding 70-feet in height are subject to review by the Airport Land Use Commission.
