We own APN 901-040-009 in Rancho Carrillo. We have no intentions of selling our property or a piece thereof to Riverside County for the placement of a radio tower. The tower's location would render the rest of the property unsellable and would destroy the aesthetics of the property. This would adversely affect the value of both that parcel as well as our home and property on the lot immediately adjacent to lot 901-040-009.

We understand that instead of parcel 901-040-009 the county is currently pursuing the property owned by the U.S. National Forest on the other side of our parcel outside of Rancho Carrillo. This will still be in full view of our home and any such tower would need to be noise free, without any lights, and aesthetically appealing for a location within the national forest.

We spent millions of dollars securing our property and home in Rancho Carrillo. We are deeply concerned and troubled that a tower in such close proximity would adversely affect the value of our land and our home. We simply do not want a tower placed that close to our community.
