Thank you for sending the notice of the County's proposed communications project. The FCC would like to remind the County that it is required to comply with all of the FCC environmental regulations. At a minimum, the County or its contractor should coordinate this project with the California State Historic Preservation Office. An FCC Form 620 Submission Packet is required for each new tower project. Also, the County is required to notify any Indian Tribes that might have an interest in this area about the proposed towers. The Tribes may be contacted by using the Commission's Tower Construction Notification System (TCNS). Based on the information sent to the Commission, the County may already have started the compliance process.
